Had a great day at Paola. Was glad to see the old faces and several new ones.

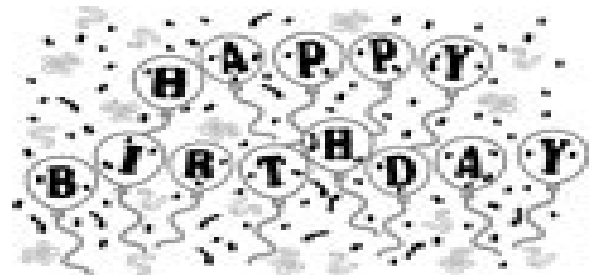
Our Summer season is off to a great start! Thank you to everyone that gives their constant support to the association. Your continued volunteering is greatly appreciated.

Books will be re-opened for those that were unable to enter the May 6th rodeo. The call-in date of June 25th from 6-9 p.m. at 785-234-2850 will also be for the make-up rodeo. **You must call-in to enter for the rodeo on June 30 and July 1 at Burlingame.**

Due to the addition of the Friday night rodeo, the 48 hour rule applies to the Friday night rodeo which starts at 7:00 p.m. Therefore,

all entries taken after 9:00 p.m. on Monday night June 25th, through Wednesday night June 27th at 7:00 p.m. will be assessed a late fee of \$10.00 per contestant. **NO ENTRIES WILL BE TAKEN AFTER 7:00 p.m., Wednesday June 27th. Monthly rule:

For clarification on call-ins.....

If the call-in for a rodeo is on a Monday night from 6-9 p.m., this is the time to call so you are not charged a \$10.00 late fee. You have 24 hours after books close to draw out of a rodeo. Books will always close at 9:00 p.m. on the night of the call-in if the rodeo is a CYRA produced rodeo. (Rodeos produced by other contractors are Blairstown and Anderson County Fair. Both have different call-in times. The 24 hours still applies.) Therefore, you will have until 9:00 p.m. on the following night to draw out, without penalty. Taking call-ins after the books close, is a courtesy. So, any entry taken between the time the books close at 9:00 p.m. and 48 hours prior to rodeo start time of the first day of a two day rodeo, will be charged the \$10.00 late entry fee. No entries will be taken after the 48 hour period has expired. NO EXCEPTIONS, NO EXCUSES! If you have any questions, please contact the call-in liaison Jeff Smith.

If you plan to ride an exhibition, exhibition rides will only be taken for a Saturday performance. Please indicate an exhibition ride when you call-in. Exhibition rides will only be accepted 1 time from any contestant.

A reminder....

Members that have joined CYRA on or before April 3rd, must have a copy of their birth certificate, and a copy of proof of school enrollment if in grades 9-12 to the association secretary by the next rodeo on June 2nd. If these documents are not in your file, you will not be allowed to compete in the upcoming Burlington rodeo. This rule is in the 2007 rule book on page 2 under MEMBERSHIP, rule 1.) C.

Parents Reminder - If your CYRA member intends on participating in the 2007 Finals, there must be family help in a minimum of 1 rodeo in the 2007 season. This is a qualification for each member. You need only fill out the form 1 time, but continued help throughout the season is greatly appreciated. This is not for "points" for members. The members will not receive additional points for any reason. However, please remember it is a qualification for members to participate in Finals or to receive year end awards. The Participation Form is available at each rodeo, and located at the entry table. The youth event directors will be taking names and noting the duties during each event. All you have to do is to fill out the form.

For HS members that come to the rodeos by themselves, it will be your responsibility to help out at a minimum of 1 rodeo in order for you to qualify to participate in Finals. You must fill out the form.
