

April Meeting Minutes 2007

The monthly meeting of the Christian Youth Rodeo Association was brought to order by Adult President Wayne Whiting at the Citizens State Bank in Paola, Kansas at 7:12 p.m. on April 11, 2007.

February meeting minutes were read by Youth Secretary Ali McKiernan. Minutes were approved as read.

Youth Treasurer Paige Wiseman read the treasurer report for the month's of February and March. Report was received as read.

Visitor Jenny Eastwood was at the meeting to offer her bullfighting skills. She has offered to come fight for free at the upcoming Ottawa rodeos and do some acts. Adult board member David Tillman moves to allow Jenny to fight she sheep, calves, and steers for of charge at Ottawa. Motion passed.

After much discussion about the forecast of incoming snow for the weekend, it was decided to wait until Saturday to decide on whether or not to have the rodeos at Ottawa.

Ali McKiernan brought up that the royalty plans to sell cookie dough to raise money for the 2008 pageant.

Desiree Garcia told us there will be an article in the Mi. Co. Republic about the association. She has vendors coming to the rodeo, and that on May 19th there will be a car wash at the Paola Wal-Mart. Wal-Mart will supply the water. The car wash will be from 10-2 p.m.

Desi got quotes on a PA system for the association. Adult Vice President Trisha Allenbrand moves we purchase a new PA system. Motion passed.

A suggestion of selling CYRA t-shirts to help pay for the sound system was brought up by Desi. Adult Treasurer Samantha Donner moves CYRA has some fund raisers to replenish the funds from purchasing the PA system, starting with the car wash on the 19th. Motion passed.

Dave Slyter said he would be bringing the box of bibles that Judy Johnson brought to us in February. Dave also said he has Chad Chambers scheduled to be the speaker at Ottawa's rodeo for Cowboy Church.

Bridgett Smith told us that Y Bar H, formerly Lloyd's Dog and Horse, has donated pole bases to the association.

Trisha brought some completed event director vests for us to see. It was decided that the event directors would have red vests with Event Director on the back, and the judges would get blue vests with Judge on the back. The CYRA logo will go on the front on the left chest.

The Pope family has volunteered to be in charge of the ½ and ½ ticket sales at each rodeo.

Adult Secretary Reta Breithaupt let everyone know about the saddle that Fletcher's from Blue Springs, Missouri has given the association to raffle off.

Wayne brought up that at the present time, the 2007 Finals is tentatively set for Mound City. It has been brought to his attention that some of the members would like to have the Finals moved back to its original location of Ottawa. We will discuss this further on a later date.

David moves to adjourn to executive session at 8:25 p.m.

In executive session, it was discussed the bullfighters will be paid \$50 per performance. David will be in charge of the bullfighters and make all necessary phone calls to schedule them. Jake Cody has offered to fight 10 rodeos for free, if he could have a flag made for him, representing his company. Brandon Newbanks and Mark Saving will fight at the first set of rodeos in Ottawa.
